## **Case Description**

These companies have been conducting money transfer activities on the island of St. Maarten and Curacao in violation of the National Ordinance on foreign exchange system of the Netherlands Antilles (P.B. 1981, no 67). Pursuant to article 10 paragraph 2 of the mentioned National Ordinance all institutions or persons engaged in the business of money transfer are required to have a foreign exchange license from the Bank to operate in the Netherlands Antilles.
